FLIGHT ADVISORY
VIP Temporary Flight Restriction
Martha's Vineyard
August 23-30, 2009

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in support of the United States Secret Service and the Office of the President of the United States will be issuing a Temporary Flight Restriction (TFR) for Martha's Vineyard, Massachusetts. The TFR will go into effect on August 23, 2009 at 1430 UTC (1030 Local) until August 30, 2009 at 2100 UTC (1700 Local). Any supporting TFRs will be published in future NOTAM(s).

The times for this TFR may change with little or no notice. Check published NOTAM for latest information.

Pursuant to 49 USC 40103(B), The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) classifies the airspace defined in this NOTAM(s) as "National Defense Airspace". Any person who knowingly or willfully violates the rules concerning operations in this airspace may be subject to certain criminal penalties under 49 USC 46307. Pilots who do not adhere to the following procedures may be intercepted, detained and interviewed by Law Enforcement/USSS/Security Personnel.

Be advised that noncompliance with the published NOTAM may result in the use of force.

To ensure the airspace is secure during this event, airspace restrictions will be in place around Martha's Vineyard. The restrictions are designed to provide a safe and secure environment, but also ensure fair and equitable access to all airspace users, to the greatest extent possible. The restrictions will allow commercial flight operations to continue and are designed to minimize the impact on private pilots.

The NOTAM(s) discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAM(s) frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. Pilots are strongly suggested to contact a Flight Service Station at 1-800-WX-BRIEF (1-800-992-7433) prior to flight to check for all current NOTAMs.

Martha Vineyard's Temporary Flight Restrictions

There will be a 10/30NMR TFR centered on 412346N/0703646W or the Martha's Vineyard MVY VOR/DME.

The Martha's Vineyard TFR includes the airspace from surface up to but not including FL 180.

Be advised that noncompliance with the published NOTAM may result in the use of force.

INNER CORE: Within 10 NMR, access will be permitted as follows:

- Law enforcement, military aircraft, emergency/life saving flights (medical/law enforcement/firefighting) operations must coordinate with ATC prior to departure at 508-968-7126.
- Regularly scheduled commercial passenger and all-cargo carriers operating under one of the following TSA-approved standard security programs: Aircraft Operator Standard Security Program (AOSSP), Full-All Cargo Aircraft Operator Standard Security Program (FACAOSSP), Model Security Program (MSP), Twelve Five Standard Security Program (TFSSP) All Cargo Only, or All-Cargo International Security Procedure (ACISP) and are arriving into and/or departing from 49 CFR Part 1542 covered airports.
- All other aircraft not operating under TSA-approved standard security programs listed above and arriving KMOVY must be security screened at a designated gateway airport. Aircraft departing KMOVY must be security screened at KMOVY. Aircraft must register for gateway access at least 72 hours prior to the planned flight.
- Other aircraft operations deemed appropriate by the United States Secret Service (USSS) will be permitted.

OUTER RING: From 10 TO 30 NMR Access to the outer ring will be permitted as follows:

- All aircraft entering or exiting the outer ring must remain in two-way radio communications with ATC, be on an active IFR or VFR flight plan with a discrete beacon code assigned by ATC. Aircraft must be squawking the discrete at all times while in the TFR. Operations are limited to aircraft arriving or departing local airports, ATC may authorize transit operations with USSS approval. Aircraft may not loiter.

Gateway Airports

- Westchester Co Airport (KHPN), Barnstable Municipal-Boardman/Poland Airport (KHYA), and Green State Airport (KPVD) have been designated as gateway airports during this TFR to accommodate aircraft arriving into KMVY. Aircraft must register for gateway access at least 96 hours prior to the planned flight.
- TSA screening will be available from 0908231000 UTC (08/23 0600 local) to 0908310000 UTC (08/30 2000 local) daily at each gateway and KMVY.
- Aircraft requiring a waiver to access this special event TFR must apply using the special event waiver form at <https://waiver.c3.faa.gov/> (case sensitive - use lower case only).
- Aircraft departing KMVY during the TFR must also apply for a waiver.
- Special ATC procedures and routes to and from these airports may be assigned prior to departure from a gateway airport. Upon departing the gateway airport, all aircraft must maintain radio contact with ATC and continuously squawk an ATC-assigned discrete transponder code. Intermediate stops are not authorized unless an emergency exists.
